The rapid growth of China's local but unique user-centered applications such as WeChat, AliPay, Didi among their users indicates an open space for HCI research in this unique cultural, locale and market context. Questions such as why and how these local applications' designs work, including their user psychological attributes, norms, cultural backgrounds are valuable for HCI researchers to understand the users in this context, and also formatively imply new designs for these users and beyond.

This special track welcomes theoretical, critical and empirical researches that look into this context, in various domains not limited to social media, community, P2P sharing, eCommerce, privacy, and so on.

Topics include, but not limited to:

- Features of user-centered Chinese applications
- HCI-related Chinese cultural uniqueness
- User-centered HCI in the Chinese market context
- Philological and cultural background of Chinese-oriented user-centered HCI
- Special user-centered Chinese cultural design paradigms
- Common global research and technologies from a Chinese perspective
- Critical and empirical research derived from Chinese-oriented approaches
