As increasing number of researchers and organizations have moved their computing infrastructure to cloud, geo-related cloud computing would become the next challenge to both geo-processing and cloud computing communities.

The special track, **GSAGC: Geo-spatial Services and Applications in Green Cloud**, aims at establishing a new study, which primarily combines concepts, algorithms, approaches, and systems in the fields of geo-spatial and cloud computing for geo-spatial computing on cloud. Contributions of "state-of-the-art" big geo-data processing, geo-related energy-saving management, geo-related modeling or simulations, geo-related scheduling, geo-related reliability approaches in cloud are encouraged to the GSAGC special track.

### Topics include, but not limited to:

- Design or solution for geo-spatial or location-based cloud computing
- Big geo-data, spatial-data, or location-based data processing and management
- Performance improvement algorithms, approaches, solutions, or systems for geo-spatial or location-based applications on cloud
- Energy efficient approaches or systems for geo-spatial or location-based applications on cloud
- Modeling, simulations, monitoring solutions for geo-spatial or location-based applications on cloud
- Reliability and fault tolerance for geo-spatial or location-based applications on cloud
