Ambient Assisted Living for patients (AAL4P) concerns progresses in ambient assisted systems for e-Care and remote-Care of patients in their living ambient.

Homecare of the patients is mainly of concern to their relatives, and this can be a limitation for patients affecting their wellbeing.
