Currently, Dr. Snow is a Professor in the McClure School of Information and Telecommunication Systems (ITS) at Ohio University. As part of ITS, he is an active researcher, teacher, and mentor. From July 2002 through June 2007, Snow was the Chair of the School, Graduate Director and Undergraduate Director. His recent publications appear in journals such as IEEE Transactions on Reliability, IEEE Transactions on Engineering Management, Journal of Networks and Systems Management, Telecommunications Policy, Journal on Mobile Networks and Applications, International Journal of Industrial Engineering, IEEE Computer, and Information & Management. He has published in over 25 peer reviewed conference proceedings. Snow has two research streams: (1) critical information system and telecommunications infrastructure dependability, and (2) telecommunications & information system management. In the wake of 9-11, Dr Snow gave invited lectures at Columbia University and a seminar to Nippon Telephone & Telegraph executives on telecommunication infrastructure survivability. He also recently coauthored a Handbook on Critical Telecommunication Infrastructure for the National Association of Utility and Regulatory Commissioners (NARUC) on an NSF contract. Snow has also finished a draft book entitled "Project Management for Telecommunication and Networking Professionals".

## c. Professional Experience

Dr. Snow returned to academia after twenty years experience in industry and government (mostly industry). This experience was exclusively in the telecommunications, networking, and information systems fields, including product and service development. He has held positions as US Army Signal Officer, Electronics Engineer, Member of the Technical Staff, Manager, Director, Executive Consultant, Vice President, General Manager, President and CEO, and Chairman in a variety of government agencies, consulting, systems integration, and telecommunications companies.
