Dr. Krämer has been IT advisor to the state government of North Rhine-Westfalia in Germany and consultant to a corporations and research institution in Germany and abroad. He obtained a diploma (MS) and a doctorate in Computer Science from the Technical University of Berlin, Germany. He is interested in research in service-oriented computing, component-based software engineering and learning technology. He has initiated and led major IST projects starting with the very first framework program late 1983. He was a co-founder and is the editor-in-chief of the open access journal e-learning and education (eleed).



Bernd Krämer has been was actively involved in the international IARIA Conference on Mobile, Hybrid, and On-line Learning (eL&mL) since its start in 2009 with accepted papers and the organization of workshops. He has also published in the IARIA <u>Journal on Advances in Software</u>. He was awarded an IARIA Best Paper Award in 2009 for his eL&mL paper entitled "Generating Animated Learning Objects from Configurable Samples".

One of his current research activities aims to bring the methodological and technological outcomes of the 5-year research project <u>CampusContent</u> into practice and enhance the functionality of the core technology, the learning object repository network <u>edu-sharing</u>, through advanced social software components.
