



Dr. Danco Davcev is currently a full professor in Computer Science and Informatics and Director of EU Open and Distance Learning Center at the University "Sts. Cyril & Methodius", Skopje (Macedonia). He obtained the diploma of Electrical Engineering from the Faculty of Electrical Engineering at the University of Belgrade (Serbia) in 1972. He received his "Doctor – Ingenieur" degree in Computer Science from the University of ORSAY (Paris, France) in 1975 and Ph.D. degree in Computer Science and Informatics from the University of Belgrade (Serbia) in 1981. He was a Fulbright postdoctoral Fellow in UCSD (USA) during 1984/85 and visiting professor at several Universities in USA during 2001/2002.

He has more than 250 research papers presented on International Conferences or published in International Journals in Computer Science and Informatics.

His research interests include Multimedia Databases and retrieval, 3D modeling, Intelligent Information Systems and HCI, Databases and Data warehouses, Distance Learning Systems, Distributed systems, Wireless Sensor networks, mobile, ubiquitous and pervasive computing etc. He is a Senior Member of ACM and a Senior Member of IEEE.

Dr Davcev has been active in a number of IARIA conferences, where he served on technical and program committees, sessions chair, moderator and panelist. The conferences include International Conferences on Systems and Networks Communications, the International Conference on Mobile Ubiquitous Computing, Systems, Services and Technologies, the International Conferences on Human-Computer Interfaces, Databases, Wireless Sensor Networks, Distance Learning and Teleconferencing etc.
