

Dr Iwona Pozniak-Koszalka

Dr Iwona Pozniak-Koszalka received M.Sc. degree in mechanical engineering at the Wrocław University of Technology in Poland. Next, she worked several years in the industrial Institute of Computer Systems for Automatics and Measurements. After return to the University she received Ph.D. in computer science in 1996 and was employed as Associate Professor at the Dept. of Systems and Computer Networks, Wrocław University of Technology, Wrocław, Poland.



She teaches courses in data bases, project management, advanced systems and computer networks. She was supervisor of more than 100 M.Sc. diploma projects. She is an author of the book and more than 80 scientific papers published in journals and conference proceedings. Her research interests focus on finding the efficient methods and algorithms for optimization of computer systems and computer networks, designing database systems and computer experimentation systems. For years, she has been serving as the principle investigator of the governmental research projects in these areas.

She was the member of program committees, the co-editor of conference proceedings and the main organizer of many scientific international conferences, including Systems Science, Combelet, ICN and ICONS, APNOMS, and Polish-British Workshops organized every year (from 2001) with Coventry University. From 2005 to date she is serving as the Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Electronics, as well as the member of many committees, boards, associations, e.g. the Polish Computer Science Society. She is married, having two children.
