

Dr. Jerzy W. Grzymala-Busse is a Professor at the Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, University of Kansas. His research interests include data mining, machine learning, and rough set theory.

Dr. J. W. Grzymala-Busse authored or co-authored three books, he co-edited 12 other books, and he published more than 300 articles in scientific journals, as book chapters or in conference proceedings. He has been invited many times to give keynote or plenary talks for international conferences, to be a member of the panel, or to participate in conference committees. Papers authored or co-authored by him were awarded three times as the best domain paper and once as the best paper overall. He is a Distinguished Fellow of the Collegium of Eminent Scientists of Polish Origin and Ancestry. He is a Section Editor of the Fundamenta Informaticae and a member of ten other Editorial Boards of scientific journals. In 2014 he was elected as chair of the International Rough Set Society Advisory Board.

Dr. J. W. Grzymala-Busse has been a committee member and session chair for IARIA conferences such as ALLDATA, DBKDA and INTELLI. He delivered a keynote talk in the INTELLI 2015 conference and was a panelist in two other IARIA conferences, ALLDATA 2015 and DBKDA 2015.
