- Mr. Geraci began his career in 1987 as a Technical Writer and Editor until 1991, where he held the position as a Telecommunications Specialist, RF test Technician - and later as a Senior Telecommunications Specialist.
- From 1991 to 1997, he designed, developed and tested the production and operation of electronic equipment such as broadcast and communications systems, defined requirements including transmission capacity planning in areas such as communications, signal processing and control systems, and the enabling of Internet and Telecommunications services for the U.S. Government, where he also taught the aforementioned at various locations throughout the United States.
- In 1998 until 2000, he held the position as Sr. IT Manager within the U.S. Department of Defense, where he was responsible for applying IT project management knowledge, skills, tools, and techniques to IT project activities, assemble project teams, assigning individual responsibilities, identifying appropriate project resource needs, and developing project budgets and schedules.
- In 2000, he was selected as SME for the School of Information Technology, encompassing several dozen labs, spread across various facilities where he provided leadership, management, and instruction until 2005.

The TSG is responsible for the survey and assessment of emerging technologies within the governmental, academic and business communities, such as Information and Communications Technology (ICT), Bioinformatics, Geology, Chemistry, and Physics.
