Geo-processing data is valuable in people's lives; data collection usually takes much time and effort. However, in today's world, the spread of geodata is free and managed by a few giant organizations such as Apple/Amazon. Although people can access the data freely, it sacrifices their data privacy and exposure to endless advertisements. The non-fungible token can be used to claim data ownership and be traded openly in the crypto market, which paved a path for future data ownership and a new business model. We need to invest in this direction for the welfare of geodata researchers as well as data consumers.

We encourage contributions ranging from theoretical studies, through systems design, to subjective user studies.

Topics include, but not limited to

- Geo data representation in the public blockchain (ETH, ADA etc) systems;
- Data privacy, and data sharing systems on public blockchain (ETH, ADA etc);
- Non-fungible tokenization of geo-processing data;
- Data ownership transfer protocol design;
- Data scam detection and prevention;
- Data auction theory and implementation.
