Sung Ho Cho received the Ph.D. degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering from the University of Utah in Salt Lake City, USA, in 1989. From 1989 to 1992, he was with Electronics and Telecommunications Research Institute (ETRI) of South Korea as a senior member of technical staff. He then joined the Department of Electronic Engineering at Hanyang University, Seoul, South Korea, in 1992, where he is currently a full professor. He served as Vice Dean and later Dean of the College of Engineering (Division II) at Hanyang University from 2013 to 2017. Since 2001, he has been an active member of various committees on planning and evaluation of national R&D projects. In 2008, he founded Samsung-Hanyang Joint Research Center in Hanyang University and served as Director for 5 years.

Prof. Cho has been actively involved in numerous government and industry research projects related to signal processing, applied machine learning, radar computing, and digital health. He is currently serving as an editorial board member of several interdisciplinary journals in engineering and healthcare.
